

Please follow the following steps to apply for the PhD program:

1. Verify whether you will meet the admission requirements listed under “Admission Requirements” at the following site:

2. If you at least meet the minimum requirements, look through the research areas of potential supervisors at the above website;
3. contact the professor that you are interested in working with to discuss your potential dissertation research topic and funding possibilities (if you do not have your own source of funding); If the first professor you contact is not interested in accepting you, contact other professors of your interest;
4. If a professor agrees to accept you, submit an official application and all required materials by following the procedures described under the “How to apply” at the above website. In the application, insert the name of the professor who is interested in accepting you.
5. Pay the application fee.
6. Wait for the admission letter.

What happens after you complete your application and pay the fee:

1. The admission officer will assess your application to determine whether you meet the requirements;
2. If you meet the requirements, the application will be forwarded to the potential supervisor for final evaluation.
3. If the professor accepts you, the University will issue the admission letter together with a funding letter if fund is provided by the professor and/or the university.
4. If you do not meet the minimum requirements, your application will be rejected.
5. If you meet the minimum requirements but the professor does not accept you, I will notify you and give you an opportunity to select a different professor. If no professor is willing to accept you, your application will be rejected.
