Rationale of the Proposed Calendar Change(s):

The removal of Historiography as a required course is in keeping with one of the recommendations of the Reviewers' Report as part of the most recent Undergraduate Program Review. Its movement from third to fourth year reflects the desire of the department to still offer the course and also reflects that, for pedagogical reasons, the course should be taught as a seminar (in fact it use to be calendared as fourth year course but was moved to third year due to the number of history majors required to take it).

History 4xxxx: Historiography
Credit Weight: 0.5

Prerequisite(s): 5 FCEs in History and at least a 70% average in History courses, or permission of the instructor and department

Description: A seminar that examines changes over time in the study and the writing of history. Historiography explores the philosophical and practical complexity in thinking about, researching, and writing history within changing historical contexts. Historiography creates an awareness of diverse approaches to the study of history and provides a critical examination of historians' methods.
