The Senate Budget Committee met twice (Sept 21st and Oct 5th) since its last report to Senate. Much of the Committee's time was spent discussing and formulating a response to the Draft Strategic Plan presented to Senate on September 14th. These comments were compiled by the SBC Chair and submitted to representatives from the Board on October 12th. The Committee also considered a small number of Calendar changes, summarized below. These proposals had been approved by SUSC in advance of their consideration at SBC. Some key questions (of the respective units) are raised during SBC's evaluations of these kinds of proposed Calendar changes including: 1) the prospective enrollment in the new course / new program; and 2) the need for additional resources (e.g, teaching staff, materials, library, etc) to offer the new course. This report presents a summary of the status of items recommended for approval or tabled by the SBC. Items pertaining to the May 18th, 2012 Senate Meeting

1. Faculty of Natural Resources Management

(a) Clarification to Open Electives in HBScF

The Senate Budget Committee <u>recommends that Senate approve this calendar change</u>, as there were no additional resources requested by the academic unit to make this clarification to open electives in the HBScF program.

Items pertaining to the September 14th, 2012 Senate Meeting

2. Faculty of Natural Resources Management

(a) Addition of Lab Session to NRMT 2055

The Senate Budget Committee has <u>tabled</u> this item to its next meeting pending clarification of any resource requirements to add this laboratory section to NRMT 2055.

(b) Add GEOG 3731 and GEOL 3410 HBScF

The Senate Budget Committee <u>recommends that Senate approve this calendar change</u>, as there were no additional resources requested by the academic unit or related units (i.e. Geography or Geology) to add these elective choices in the HBScF program.

(c) Replace OUTD 3290 with OUTD 2810 in HBEM

The Senate Budget Committee recommends that Senate approve this calendar change, as there were no additional resources requested by the academic unit or related units (i.e. Outdoor Recreation) to make this substitution in the HBEM program. It was reported at SBC that the course OUTD 3290 is likely to be deleted from the Calendar as it is no longer offered.
