Peggy Tripp Memorial Women's Studies Student Award (\$500)

Upper-year student with exemplary community involvement in areas of women's issues, social justice and/or environmental issues.

Himmelman Family Bursary (\$200)

Major in Gender and Women's Studies or taking or have taken Gender and Women's Studies courses,
on the basis of financial need.

Women's Studies Bursary (\$100)

Gender and Women's Studies student on the basis of financial need and a minimum 'B' standing.
