Course Description: Provides a critical analysis of the current Canadian legal system and problematizes legal categories such as 'woman', 'spouse', 'parent', 'refugee' and 'Indian', with particular attention to the ways in which legal categories render invisible intersecting aspects of women's identities. The course also examines the ways in which women's daily lives are regulated and constrained by law, and how feminists have challenged and resisted legal categories and restrictions. Students are expected to read case law, legislation, legislative debates and jurisprudence.
