Rationale To replace the fourth year requirement that students complete INTD 4010 and INTD 4032 with a new course titled CRIM 4801- Honours Research Project. A 1FCE course focused on criminological research and taught by a criminologist will work significantly better We are introducing four new Inquiry courses (INTD 30aa, 30xx, 30yy, and 30zz, see 2015-soc-5324) in support of our proposed new concentrations (see 2015-soc-5321). These courses are suitable	

alternatives for INTD 3010. The only difference between each of them is their specific topic (INTD 3010 is a special topics course), so any of these courses will be suitable prerequisites for CRIM 4801.
