#### **Position Summary:**

Lakehead University Orillia is a member of the Ontario Collegiate Athletic Association (OCAA); we are seeking a passionate and experienced head coach for our Men's Varsity Soccer program. Reporting to the Athletics Coordinator, the successful candidate will work closely with the Athletics Coordinator and is responsible for developing a plan for the Men's Soccer program; this includes recruitment, student-athlete development, evaluating the technical, tactical, and physical components of the team. This program prepares the student-athletes for successful competition within the Ontario Colleges Athletics Association (OCAA). This is a part-time position which will require evenings, weekends, and periodic weekday daytime hours, dependent on competition schedule. Salary will be determined with experience. The candidate must possess values consistent with the standards of Lakehead University and the Ontario Collegiate Athletics Association in developing academically strong student-athletes, while also establishing a competitive Varsity Men's Soccer program.

#### **General Aspects of Program:**

• LU's Men's Soccer Program competes in Indoor Soccer through the OCAA during the Winter Semester, and will participate in Outdoor Soccer (OCAA) in the Fall of 2025 as well

• Training will start in September to prepare for Outdoor Soccer with 3-4 sessions a week (This includes Try-outs, practices, and friendlies)

• Indoor Soccer season starts in January and runs through March. This consists of approximately 3-5 tournaments, 1-2 Invitationals, Regionals in late February, Provincials in March.

#### **Responsibilities:**

o Develop a comprehensive program for the Men's Soccer team, including an annual training plan for practices and games.

o Promote the program and identify and recruit quality prospective student-athletes.

o Collaborate with the Athletics & Recreation Department for recruitment events to increase awareness of the Lakehead Orillia soccer program.

o Ensure the program's goals and objectives align with the Athletic & Recreation Department's Mission, Vision, and Values.

o Provide an inclusive, diverse, equitable, and holistic environment for student-athlete development.

o Represent Lakehead University professionally and in accordance with the university's policies.

o Follow all OCAA policies and procedures.

o Maintain effective communication and administrative systems among all coaches, studentathletes, and athletics staff.

o Ability to work evenings/weekends.

#### Qualifications:

o Proven and established relationships with high school soccer coaches and/or clubs for



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recruitment purposes.

o Minimum of 4 years of Head Coaching experience, preferably with student-athletes or highperformance athletes.

o Minimum certification: NCCP Train to Train & Train to Compete; Soccer Canada License is considered an asset.

- o Strong interpersonal, team building, and conflict resolution skills.
- o Must have a valid class G license.
- o Must provide a clear police background check.
