

Year 1 Registration Guide - Four Year BScN Program

Register for all required courses (Fall, Full Year, & Winter courses) at time of registration. The courses you are registering for are listed below with the appropriate section code. If you register for other sections, you will receive an error message.

9. Nursing Inquiry	NURS-1351-WC or NURS 1351-WE
10. Relational Nursing Practice 2	NURS-1512-WC or NURS 1512-WE** (Clinical one day per week)
11. Lab for Nurs-1512	NURS-1512L-W1 - W10 (choose <i>1 lab only</i> that is conflict free)
12. Quantitative Methods Health Sc.	Choose Math-0212- FA
and Lab for Math 0212	OR Math-0212-FB
	AND Math-0212L-F1 (lab)

* If you received **Advanced Standing for Nurs-1080-YA** you must register for **Nurs-1011-YA** (this is the health assessment theory portion) and choose <u>one</u> of the labs for **NURS-1011L-Y1 – Y11** (choose 1 lab only that is conflict free).

**** The NURS-1512 Clinical Placement** will not show on your student schedule in the Winter term. The placement will be one day per week, on a Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday (approx. 0700 to 1330 hrs). Further information will be provided in the Winter term by the clinical course lead via email.

To be eligible for the NURS-1512 Clinical Placement you must submit all required clinical documents to Synergy. The due date is October 20th. Please see the School of Nursing website for further information about <u>Required Clinical Documents</u>.
